## PSAT Testing

Once again Mt. Salus will be administering the PSAT to help your children in their preparation for college entrance. Mt. Salus will cover the cost of the test for all 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students who have not yet taken the test. If your child has already taken the test, but you would like for them to retake it, we will charge the standard testing fee of \$14 per student. Makes checks payable to Mt. Salus Christian School (memo PSAT). Please contact Chris Shaw, our counselor, no later than Monday, September 12<sup>th</sup> so that your child can be added to the list.

The testing date will be **Wednesday, October 12, at 8:00 a.m.** The testing location will be at **Parkway Baptist Church**. You will need to bring your child directly to the Church that morning by 7:40. Testing time is 2 hours and 10 minutes with a short break in the middle. We will transport them back via the school bus to the Mt. Salus campus when testing is finished and you can pick them up from the campus at the normal time.

They will need a pencil, eraser and calculator. Scratch paper will be available for them during the testing. If they would like to bring a small snack for the break, they may do so.
